The Haus der Geschichte in Bonn is one of Germany's most visited museums. Every year, around 850,000 visitors flock to the approximately 4,000 m² exhibition space, which presents German history from the post-war period to the present day. The permanent exhibition displays around 7,000 objects from political, economic, cultural and everyday history since 1945.

The complete redesign of the permanent exhibition was designed by Kossmanndejong. SemMika acted as technical advisor on behalf of Kossmanndejong and was responsible for the technical design of the video projections, the audiovisual and interactive systems, the associated e- and data installations and the tendering process for the system integrator. The realization was carried out by 235 Media from Cologne.

The Nieuwe Schatkamer is the publicly accessible exhibition space in the renovated headquarters of De Nederlandsche Bank in Amsterdam. Spread over three floors, visitors discover the world of gold, money and economics through objects from the money and art collection.

One of the highlights is the Vault-experience, an audiovisual show by Redrum, in the former gold vault that brings to life the history and meaning of gold.

The exhibitions were designed by Studio Platvorm, with interactive contributions from IJsfontein. Interior construction and system-integration were carried out by Kloosterboer.

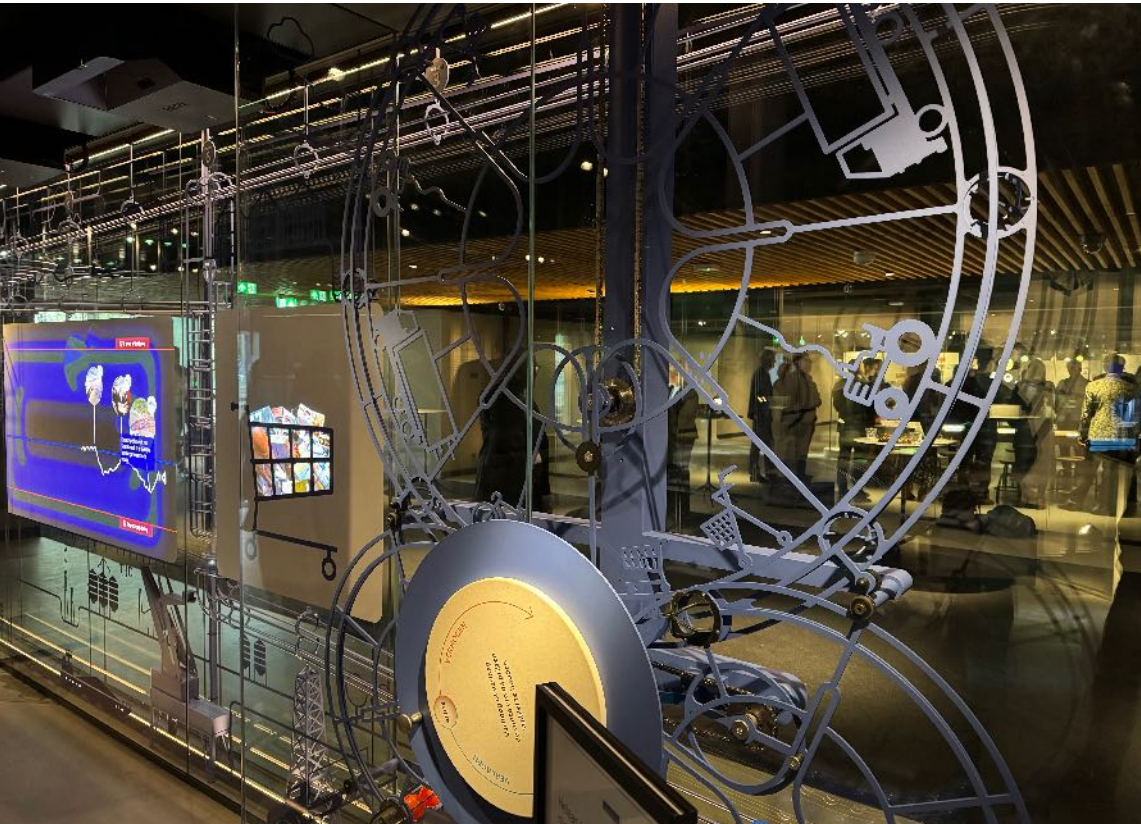

On March 22, 2025, Portlantis, the Port of Rotterdam Authority's new visitor center, opened on Maasvlakte 2. It offers an interactive exploration of the world of Europe's largest port.

The iconic building, designed by MVRDV, consists of five twisted volumes and offers panoramic views of the port, coastline and North Sea. Inside, a permanent exhibition - developed by Kossmanndejong and Piet-Harm Sterk - highlights the history, operations and future of the port, including themes such as energy transition and digitalization.

Portlantis replaces FutureLand and is the new home of the EIC, which introduces young people to the port. There are also conference rooms and a restaurant.

From the development phase, SemMika acted as a consultant to the Port Authority in the areas of AV hardware, lighting and ShowControl control and procurement.

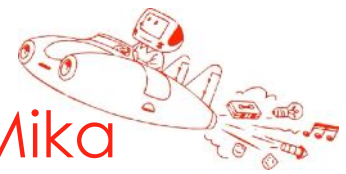

Museum Bronbeek in Arnhem is a national museum highlighting the colonial military history of the Netherlands, with an emphasis on the Dutch presence in Indonesia between 1816 and 1962. It is located on Bronbeek estate, which has served as both a museum and a home for former soldiers since 1863.

The new permanent exhibition, designed by Opera Amsterdam, gives visitors insight into the rise and fall of the Dutch East Indies. Themes of colonial rule, war, society and independence struggles are covered, as well as contemporary reflections on this shared past.

SemMika was responsible for designing the AV hardware, drawing up the Program of Requirements and supervising the tender. During the realization phase SemMika also took care of the lighting programming.

The University Museum Utrecht is a family museum that invites visitors to discover the world of science. In five interactive exhibition rooms, visitors explore the scientific research of Utrecht University, from the past to the present. They can experiment themselves and discover how science works.

The museum manages the university's academic and cultural heritage, with over 200,000 objects. The historic botanical garden, the Old Hortus, is also part of the museum and provides a green oasis in the city.

Paleis Het Loo in Apeldoorn is a former royal palace that has served as a national museum since 1984. Built between 1684 and 1686 for Stadholder William III and Mary II, the museum offers rich insight into the history of the Dutch royal family after a large-scale renovation.

The museum displays both permanent and temporary exhibits. An important part is the permanent exhibition "De Oranjes," designed by Kossmanndejong, which tells the story of the House of Orange. For children aged 3 to 12, there is the interactive Junior Palace.

SemMika was involved as AV consultant in the realization of "The Oranges" in the East Wing, the Junior Palace in the West Wing and the arrangement of the introductory film in the Lower House.

The Media Museum at Beeld & Geluid in Hilversum, reopening Feb. 11, 2023, is known as the most interactive media museum in the world. Visitors explore five zones - Sharing, Informing, Playing, Selling and Telling - each filled with interactive installations. For example, they can create news, peruse advertisements, tell stories or design games.

At the center of the museum is the Media Reactor, a 300-meter-long video installation that depicts the constant flow of media from the archive.

SemMika, with Rutger van Dijk as technical project manager, was responsible for design, tendering, construction supervision, technical coordination, programming, lighting direction and budget monitoring of this extensive project with more than fifty interactives, hundreds of hours of AV content and a wealth of media objects.

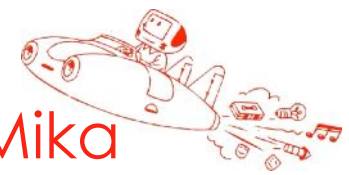

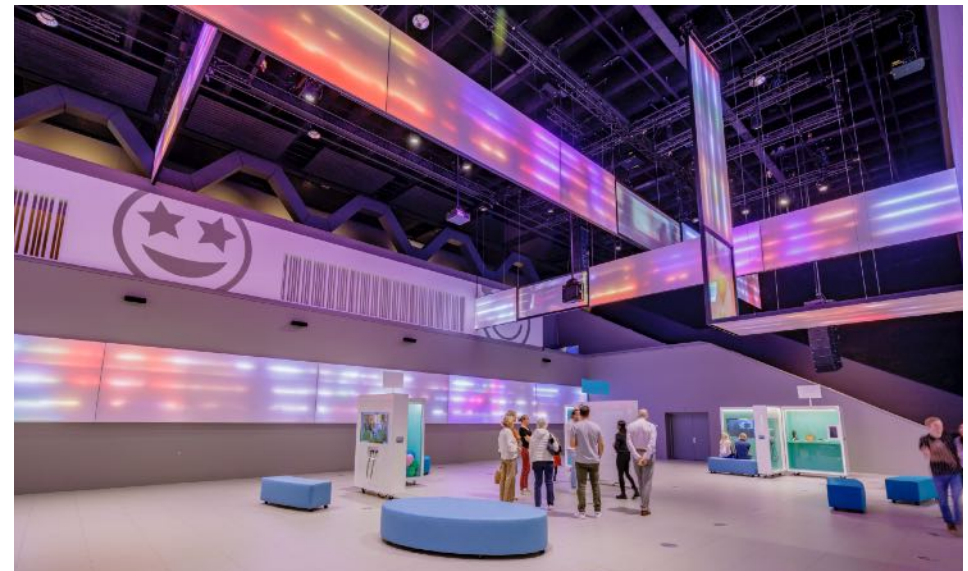

The Verzetsmuseum Amsterdam developed the new permanent exhibition together with Studio Ilona Laurijsse, YiPP, Shosho and HeinzLoopstra.

The exhibition, titled "The Netherlands in World War II," tells the story of a country under occupation through personal perspectives and moral dilemmas. In an impressively designed setting, visitors walk through six successive stages of the war years.

Each phase is introduced with a large film projection that outlines the political and international context. Within these frames, intimate, personal stories bring the broader history to life and show how ordinary people faced extraordinary choices.

Het Groote Museum

ARTIS Amsterdam

On May 12, 2022, ARTIS reopened the Groote Museum to the public after being closed for 75 years. The monumental museum on Artisplein reopened with an innovative concept that focuses on the interconnectedness between humans, animals, plants and microbes. Visitors here experience not only differences and similarities, but especially the interconnectedness of all life on earth.

The Groote Museum, located in Amsterdam's oldest museum building (1855), has been sustainably restored and renewed as a national monument. The reopening marks an important milestone in ARTIS' future plan to allow visitors to look at the world around them with fresh eyes.

The exhibition design was realized by Kossmanndejong and implemented turn-key by Bruns and Ata Tech. In addition to the exhibition, the project includes three event spaces, with audiovisual installations provided by Phanta Vision.

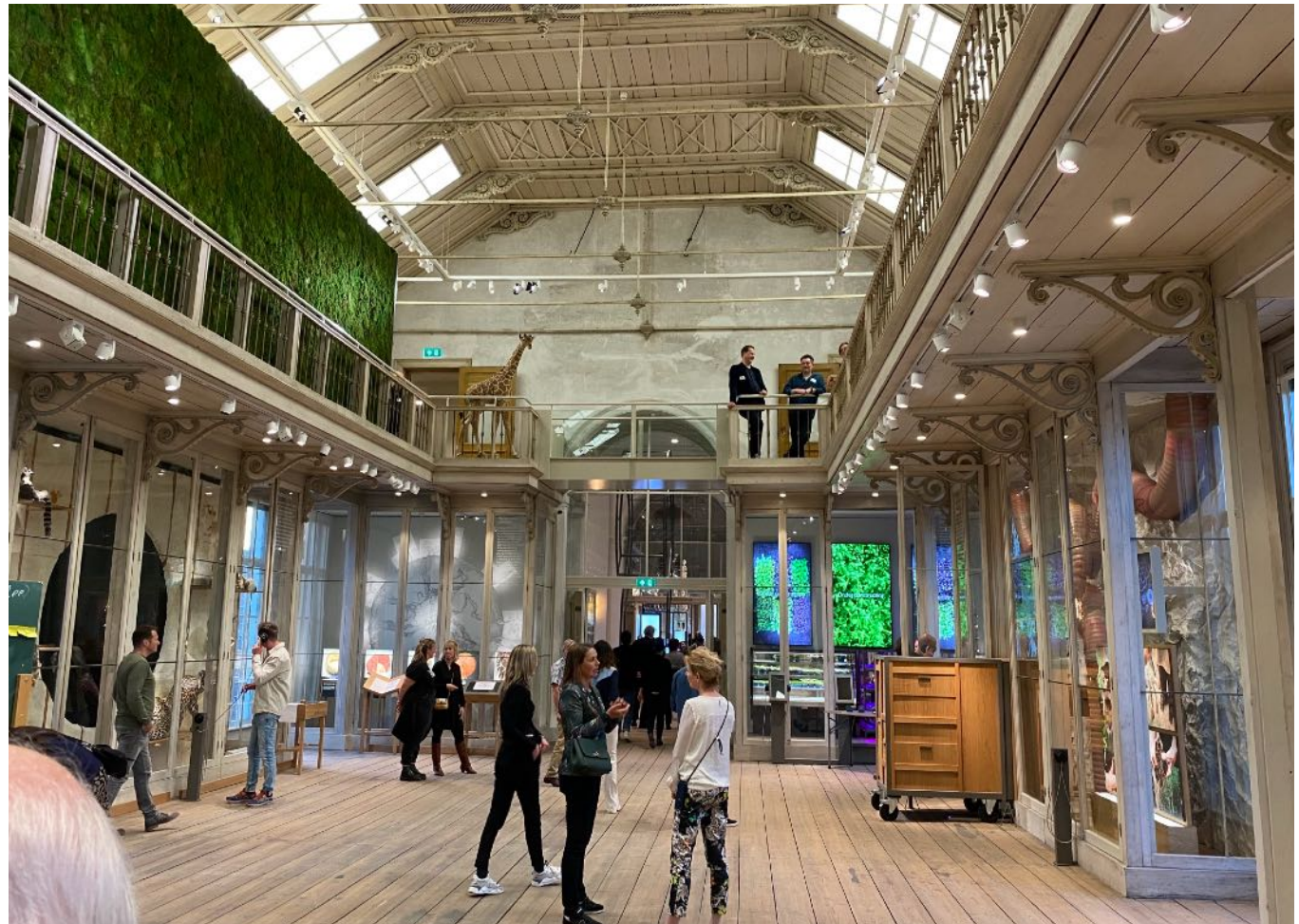

Land of Dreamers Who Do

UAE Paviljoen Expo 2020 Dubai

For the UAE pavilion at the Dubai Expo, HeinzLoopstra Lightdesign, in collaboration with Kossmanndejong and Tellart, developed the lighting design for the Land of Dreamers Who Do exhibition. The iconic pavilion building, designed by Calatrava, was awarded an AD Design Award 2021.

The experience unfolds as a meandering path that takes visitors through six interactive and immersive sections, each telling a different chapter of the United Arab Emirates' story.

HeinzLoopstra Lightdesign was responsible for the lighting design, while SemMika developed the lighting control design. In addition, SemMika provided the technical documentation and acted as a link in all technical and production communication between HeinzLoopstra Lightdesign, KDJT and the technical producer.

Naturalis in Leiden is the national natural history museum and research institute with more than 120 scientists. With approximately 43 million objects, it is among the largest natural history collections in the world. The museum offers interactive, permanent exhibitions on evolution, biodiversity, the Ice Age and the relationship between humans and nature, among other topics. In 2021, Naturalis was awarded the European Museum of the Year Award.

The thematic galleries were designed by several exhibition designers: Pieter Aartsen (Live Science, The Earth), Daniel Ament (Ice Age, Japanese Theater, Rexperience), Event Communications (Dinotime), Kossmanndejong (Life, Death), and Designwolf (The Seduction, The Earliest Man).

SemMika was involved in design, tendering and realization: from advice on system integration to design of show control and lighting direction, and responsible for AV and lighting project management, planning, budget monitoring and show control and lighting programming.

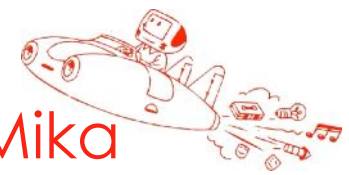

Museum de Proefkolonie

Stichting Maatschappij van Weldadigheid



Museum De Proefkolonie in Frederiksoord highlights a unique social experiment from 1818, when General Johannes van den Bosch founded the Maatschappij van Weldadigheid. In this "trial colony," poor urbanites were given a new chance through agriculture and education. Visitors experience the past through a multimedia time travel, from urban poverty to building a new existence.

In 2021, Frederiksoord, as part of the Colonies of Weldadigheid, was recognized as a UNESCO World Heritage Site. In cooperation with ACT2 and the Prison Museum, an updated experience center was realized, in which visitors follow in the footsteps of the first settlers.
